From McMinnville Walmart at Hwy 70, go North on Old Smithville Rd/ Yager Road for about 3.9 miles to 3-way stop, then go straight thru (changes to Lucky Road) continue on Lucky Road for about 8 miles where the road changes to **Judge Warren Road to 1310** on right at auction site. From Woodbury, go to Short Mtn. Fire Station (just past Short Mtn. School) and follow orange auction signs to auction.
